



AQUA-HOT DEBUTS 250D FOR SMALL CLASS A DIESEL PUSHERS

Aqua-Hot Heating Systems, the leader in RV hydronic heating solutions, has added the 250D to its 200 Series line-up. Ideal for smaller RVs that already have diesel onboard, it debuts at RVX, March 12-14, Salt Lake City, booth 2339, and is already available on Tiffin Motorhome's Allegro RED as an option.

The Aqua-Hot 250D delivers 40,000 Btu/hr of enveloping warmth without the annoyance of cold spots or dry, blowing air. Low-voltage fans ensure exceptionally quiet operation. Similar to luxury residential and high-end motorhome systems, it is set by a thermostat and uses highly efficient heat exchangers and/or in-floor radiant heating.

Multifunctional, the Aqua-Hot 250D also provides continuous hot water, eliminating the need for a separate water heater. Delivering a 1.5 gpm flow at 110° F-120° F, it's ideal for showering, laundry and other uses.

The Aqua-Hot 250D is fueled by diesel and operated by 12VDC for off-grid applications. The system also utilizes a 110VAC electric element when the coach is plugged into shore power. Compact and lightweight, it's 21.61" L x 12.45" W x 11.69" D, and weighs 84 lbs. empty and 113 lbs. full.

The all-in-one design is straightforward to install. Heating, water and fuel ports are located on top for easy connection. An integrated mounting tray facilitates air intake and exhaust.
