



PROSPEC DEBUTS TWO INFINITY BY HARMAN MARINE AMPLIFIERS

Dedicated stereo amplifiers still reign supreme when it comes to delivering audiophile-quality sound reproduction. Prospec Electronics introduces two new models from Infinity by Harman boasting Class-D technology. Developed for a marine environment, they're debuting at IBEX, Oct. 2-4, booth 1311 and slip 16D.

The weather-resistant Infinity by Harman M704A and M4555A amplifiers were engineered to deliver massive, clear sound in compact packages. They feature selectable all-, high-, or low-pass crossovers with variable electronic frequency adjustment for precise system tuning.

The four-channel, 4x100W RMS @ 2 ohms Infinity by Harman M704A marine amplifier has an impressive 1,000W of peak power. The chassis is 14.125" L x 7.313" W x 3.25" H and weighs 9.5 lbs.

With five channels, the 4x65W RMS @ 2 ohms Infinity by Harman M4555A has a walloping 1,800W of peak power and a dedicated subwoofer channel. The subwoofer output is rated at 500W x 1 RMS @ 2ohms. It weighs 10 lbs. and measures 15.75" L x 7.5" W x 2.375" H.

Prospec Electronics' Infinity by Harman M704A costs \$299.95; the M4555A is \$399.95.
