SeaSucker Cup Holders are made in the USA for an extreme environment. Durable UV-stabilized rubber and 316 stainless steel hardware ensure a long life. Cup inserts are removable for easy cleaning and to swap-out with the company's Small Dry Box—perfect for a cell phone. They're available in white or black to match any décor.

What separates the SeaSucker Cup Holder from all others is its innovative 4.5" Vacuum Mount. Unlike a common suction cup that quickly loses its seal, it has massive, long-term holding power—even on textured and curved surfaces.

SeaSucker Cup Holders are simple to use. The non-marking mount is placed on any clean, non-porous surface and the integrated power button is pumped several times. When it's time to move or stow the device, a tab quickly breaks the seal. A video is at bit.ly/CupHolders.
