The problem with hand-held electronics is that hands drop them. SeaSucker doesn't—even during happy hour. Its innovative Naked Flex Mount modular system installs almost anywhere without drilling holes and holds a wide range of devices, whether it's a GPS on the helm, GoPro capturing wakeboard action or tablet playing a movie down below.

The Naked Flex Mount is a 7" flexible, yet sturdy gooseneck arm with a 4.5" Vacuum Mount installed on either end. Unlike a mere suction cup, each has 120 lbs. of holding power when installed on a clean, non-porous surface. Made in the USA for a marine environment, the UV-stabilized rubber is non-marking and all hardware is 316 stainless steel.

Used by itself, the Naked Flex Mount is perfect for holding a tablet or larger smartphone. For smaller devices, one of the Vacuum Mounts can be removed and a Flex-X Phone Adapter added. Its unique frame expands to accommodate different size devices while keeping them secure. The GoPro Adapter attaches similarly and holds GoPro and Garmin VIRB cameras.

Available in black or white, the SeaSucker Naked Flex Mount sells for \$105; Flex-X Phone Adapter, \$35; and GoPro Adapter, \$10.
